

## COUNCIL MEMBER – Industry

### Meetings and Committees:

- As a member of Council, the Council Member for Industry will attend the three meetings of the Society’s Advisory Council held each year (traditionally in January, April, and October).
- At the Advisory Council meetings, this Council Member will deliver a report concerning industry engagement and related developments relevant to the Society.
- This Council Member should also attend the Society’s Annual Charity Meeting and Annual General Meeting.

### Key Responsibilities:

This Council Member’s role is to represent members of the Nutrition Society working within, or collaborating with, industry sectors relevant to nutrition science.

The individual in this role is responsible for the following:

1. Supporting engagement between the Society and industry stakeholders in line with the Society’s charitable objectives and governance requirements.
2. Developing and maintaining relationships with relevant industry organisations and partners.
3. Supporting the development of industry-related scientific activities and knowledge exchange opportunities.
4. Promoting evidence-based nutrition science within industry engagement activities.
5. Supporting networking opportunities for members working across industry and applied nutrition sectors.
6. Providing advice to Council on emerging developments, innovation and collaboration opportunities within industry.
7. Supporting collaboration between academic, clinical, policy and industry stakeholders.
