Registration & Attendance

How do I register for the conference?

Delegates can register online via the official conference registration page. Once your registration is complete, you will receive a confirmation email with your booking details.

If you are a **Nutrition Society member**, you will need to log into your 'membership and more' area, then go up to the science tab of the website to register, so that you get your discount for the conference.

What is included in my registration fee?

Can I transfer my registration to another person?
